










Participation Basis and Structure of the Conference Sessions

The Conference sessions welcome papers approaching theoretical studies and empirical research, good practice examples or lessons learnt in practice.


General Guidelines and Paper Format/Publication Norms*



Please make sure to respect the following:

- The papers must be unpublished work.
- The abstracts and full papers should be submitted for review in electronic format: MS Word
- Papers are to be submitted in the official language of the Conference, English, containing a title, a short abstract (between 200 and 300 words), six key words as well as a 6 row bio note about the author(s).
- Please provide the full names, affiliations, mailing addresses, telephone numbers, and e-mail addresses of the authors, indicating the contact author.
- Please include in the e-mail containing the paper the session topic for which you are submitting the article and also the partner journal in which you want to publish.
- Please double-check spelling, syntax, composition and layout.

Remember: The editorial board, reserves the right, upon the double blind review by the referents, to publish or reject any of the received papers and to suggest changes that may be considered necessary, based on a double blind peer review procedure.

*For the publication of a full paper there is a processing fee of 90 euros for professors and 40 euros for PhD candidates. The payment proof will be required upon sending the full paper for publication to the email address: **fss conference@yahoo.ro.**
